

## Minutes of the February 6, 2023 Robinson City Council Meeting, Approved

Robinson City Council held its regular monthly meeting on Monday, February 6, 2023 at the Community Center. Mayor Lieneman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Councilpersons Traxler, Folsom, Griswold, Malott, Taylor, City Clerk Macy Bryant and Code Enforcement Officer James Traxler.

**Presentations:** None.

**Public Comment:** Lisa Willey asked if the council would consider allowing chickens within city limits. The council will look into this and respond at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

**Committee/ Department Reports:** The January 2023 Fire Department Financials were approved.

**Financials:** Councilwoman Traxler motioned to approve the November 2022 financials. Councilman Folsom seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

**Administrative:** Councilwoman Griswold motioned to approve the January 9, 2023 minutes with corrections. Councilman Taylor seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

Councilman Taylor motioned to approve the January 18, 2023 minutes as is. Councilwoman Traxler seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

**Old Business:** Councilman Malott motioned to sign the WAPA resolution. Councilwoman Griswold seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

**New Business:** The State of Kansas has issued new regulations regarding lead water service lines. The city is now required to start an inventory of all water lines within city limits, personal and public sides of the meter. A survey will be sent out with city bills to every household and business and will need to be filled out and returned to City Hall as soon as possible. **Code Enforcement Report:** James asked that the council approve a 'Public Hearing Request Form'. Councilman Folsom motioned to approve the form. Councilwoman Griswold seconded the motion. **City Clerk Report:** Councilman Folsom motioned to let the Robinson History Association use the Community Center the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of every month as needed. Councilwoman Griswold seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed with Councilman Malott abstaining from the vote.
