

Minutes of the September 13, 2023 Robinson City Council Special Meeting,  
Approved

Robinson City Council held a special meeting on Wednesday, September 13, 2023 at the Community Center. Mayor Lieneman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Councilpersons Traxler, Monson, Malott, and Taylor, City Attorney Martin Mishler and City Clerk Macy Bryant were in attendance. Also in attendance was Jesse Geiger, Robert Hoopes, Betty Kauffman and John and Tina Juarez.

**New Business:** On the South end of town there is a street that had a fence put up to block it. After further investigation, that street is not where the city has it platted therefore the city has the option of moving it over, closing it or leaving it how it is. After hearing from the surrounding property owners, the council decided to just leave the street as is. No action was needed at this time.

Councilman Taylor motioned to amend the agenda, adding code enforcement to new business. Councilwoman Traxler seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

City Attorney Martin Mishler wanted to let the council ask any questions they have about passing an ordinance allowing the code enforcement officer to write tickets. If the city passes this ordinance the code enforcement officer is still able to abate nuisances by passing a resolution. This is not a way for the city to make profit it is simply just a way to help take care of nuisances within the city. Councilman Malott asked that the city send out a letter to every residence in town letting them know of these changes, if this ordinance passes at a later date. No action was taken at this time.

**Adjournment:** Councilwoman Traxler motioned to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Taylor seconded the motion. All in favor, meeting was adjourned at 7:29 pm.
