

Minutes of the November 14, 2023 Robinson City Special Council Meeting,

Robinson City Council held a special meeting on Tuesday, November 14, 2023 at the Community Center. Mayor Lieneman called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. Councilpersons Monson, Malott, Griswold and Taylor, City Clerk Macy Bryant and Code Enforcement Officer James Traxler were in attendance. Also in attendance was Steve and Sharilyn Gilbert.

Old Business: A contract was written by the city attorney between the city judge and the city, stating the price for their services, date, and time of monthly municipal court. Councilwoman Griswold motioned to sign and accept this contract. Councilman Monson seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

Councilman Malott motioned to move forward with an abatement resolution for 209 Main Street. Councilwoman Griswold seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

A citation is being issued for 415 Golden Gate Street for cleaning up the yard and porch after previous letters from the city have been sent stating that they were in violation of the city's Health and Welfare Codes.
